Please note that instructions for the extended summary have been changed as follows.

An extended summary of literary work not yet published or presented must be submitted electronically in PDF format as defined by the web submission system of IPEC-Niigata 2005.

<u>The extended summary must not exceed 4 pages on either A4 or 8.5 by 11 inch</u> (letter size) format. Other than observing this page limit, there are no restrictions regarding style of the summary except for the following that must appear on the first page:

- Title of the paper
- Author(s) name(s)
- Affiliation
- Mailing address
- e-mail address, phone and fax numbers
- Topic track number

Extended summaries will serve for paper selection, session assignment and program development. Thus authors should clearly describe salient concepts and novel features of their work, and that distinguishes their work from that of other authors. It is a good idea to include lucid explanations with as many figures, tables, and results as possible, suggesting the contents of the final paper.

An abstract within 200 words should be typed through the web submission system. Neither tables nor figures may appear in the abstract.
